## **PART 1 EXPRESSION OF INTEREST**

The Indigenous Land and Sea Corporation (**ILSC**) are inviting expressions of interest from individuals, businesses and organisations interested in operating the Baldivis greenhouse properties (**Property**). The Property, as detailed below, includes two non-contiguous allotments made up of Lot 1 and Lot 849 Eighty Road, Baldivis, WA, 6171.







Encompassing a fully functioning, fully automated, Cravo greenhouse facility with option to extend current planting capacity, the Property offers significant scope for uncompromised year-round growing conditions.

The Property was purchased by the ILSC on the basis that significant Indigenous benefit to the Noongar People would be created through the ownership of the land. As such, the ILSC will be working closely with Gnaala Karla Booja Aboriginal Corporation (**GKBAC**) to manage the Expression of Interest process and the future use of the property.

The ILSC and GKBAC seek to facilitate the leasing of the Property to an entity that has capacity to operate at profit and a willingness to incorporate Indigenous benefits into a Lease agreement.
